All funeral directors are legally required to publish this Price List for a standardised set of products and services. This is to help you think through your options and make choices, and to let you compare prices between different funeral directors (because prices can vary).

ATTENDED FUNERAL (funeral director's charges only)	£2,375
This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person at the same time as they attend their burial or cremation.	
Taking care of all necessary legal and administrative arrangements	£805
Collecting and transporting the deceased person from the place of death (normally within 20 miles of the funeral director's premises) into the funeral director's care	£245
Care of the deceased person before the funeral in appropriate facilities. The deceased person will be kept at either the funeral director's premises or other non-branch premises	£425
Providing a suitable coffin – this will be made from oak veneer	£480
Visiting of the deceased person by family and friends, by appointment with the funeral director (where visiting is requested by the customer)	£45
At a date and time you agree with the funeral director, taking the deceased person direct to the agreed cemetery or crematorium (normally within 20 miles of the funeral director's premises) in a hearse or other appropriate vehicle	£375
UNATTENDED FUNERAL	
This is a funeral where family and friends may choose to have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person, but they do not attend the burial or cremation itself.

FEES YOU MUST PAY	
For an Attended or Unattended burial funeral, the burial fee. ¹ In this local area, the typical cost of the burial fee for local residents is: For a new grave you will also need to pay for the plot; for an existing grave with a memorial in place, you may need to pay a removal/replacement fee. In addition, the cemetry may charge a number of other fees.	£974 – £1,033
For an Attended cremation funeral, the cremation fee. ² In this local area, the typical cost of a cremation for local residents is:	£1,092 – £1,350

¹ This fee (which is sometimes called the interment fee) is the charge made for digging and closing a new grave, or for reopening and closing an existing grave.

² In England, Wales and Northern Ireland, you will usually need to pay doctors' fees as well. This is the charge for two doctors to sign the Medical Certificates for cremation.

Payment information and terms: Following an arrangement meeting between the family and ourselves, we will email you a summary of the arrangements and an estimate of costs. We request that you sign and return the agreement form on Page 2 of the estimate. We ask for 'disbursements' (third party costs that we pay on your behalf) to be paid before the funeral. Approximately a week after the funeral we will send you an invoice. If the disbursements have already been paid, the outstanding payment will be for our professional fee and any extra or amended disbursements. We request payment of the invoice within two weeks.

Payment methods: We accept payment by cash, cheque or bank transfer.
